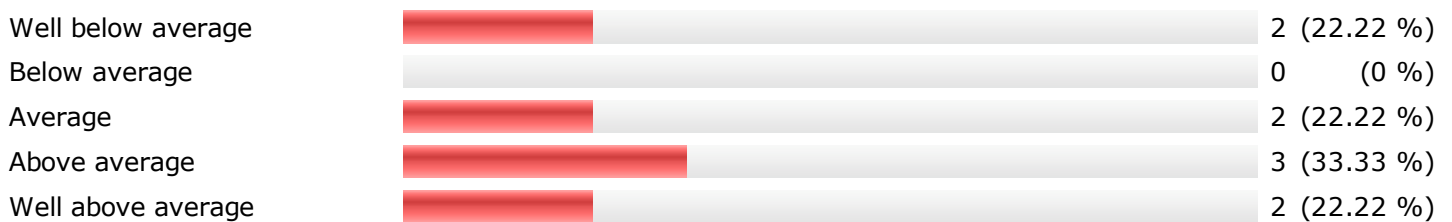

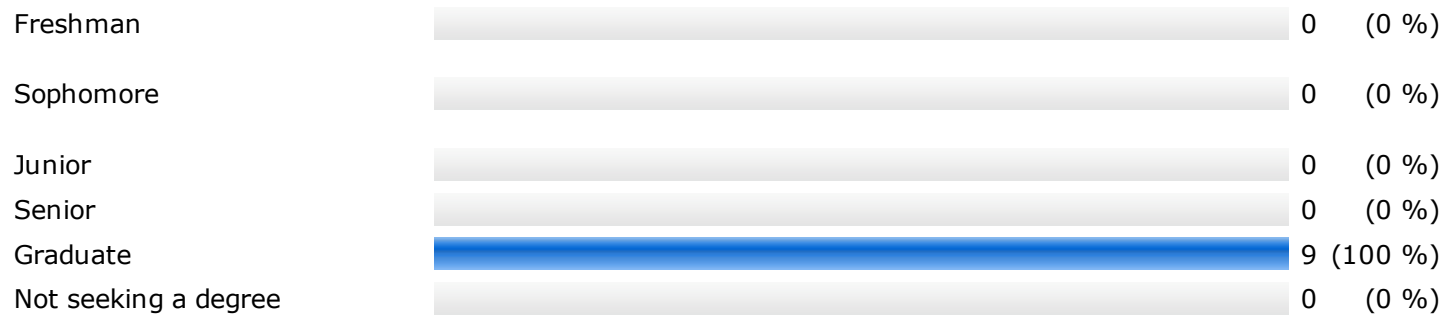

▶ a. I thought the course was well done overall. Some of the evaluation seemed off (because I had no idea that my email submission on a paper would format badly, nor did I think that I couldn't hard-type in grades on the gradesheet assignment), but for the most part the class was well-run. Also, it would be nice if the page number requirements for the assignments were clearer (i.e., tell whether papers are to be double- or single-spaced).

b. The instructor was always on top of things, creating very detailed Units, complete with excellent resources: video, informative essays, and online presentations by speakers outside the class.

c. Flesh out the assignment requirements more and give more leeway in grading to people who are not as Internet- and computer-savvy.

▶ Mr. Weber, I have to tell you how much I appreciate the organization of this course. This is the first online course I have taken at MSUB, but I had a couple other courses this semester that are half D2L and half in-person and they are so confusing! The instructors usually do not break things down, so assignments, due dates, and other criteria are easy to find. It makes life so much easier and I feel successful because of your organization.

I feel that everyone, regardless of their major, can benefit from a technology course. Really, a technology course should just be a core requirement like math or writing.

You facilitated discussions very well. You always provided feedback. You have clear expectations. You know how to run an online class.
