




### **Question 1**


Part I. Please select your opinion on the following questions:

The instructor distributed, not later than the second week of class, a written course syllabus describing the course and indicating course requirements, grading system to be utilizd, office number and location, and phone number.










#### Question 2

Compared with all the instructors I have had online, this instructor is:






